What is a Certified TTS?

A Certified Tobacco Treatment Specialist (CTTS) has completed an intensive training program accredited by the Association for the Treatment of Tobacco Use and Dependence (ATTUD). This growing group of professionals have an advanced and specialized skill set that makes them a valuable addition to any interdisciplinary team. A CTTS can work in many healthcare settings and may be eligible to bill for tobacco cessation services.

If you:

- Work in an agency or system that serves tobacco users,
- Want to add tobacco cessation treatment to your skill set, or
- Are interested in offering critical health services,

then the RMTTS-C Program is right for you!

After attending this 4-day accredited program, you can become certified as a Tobacco Treatment Specialist.

The RMTTS-C Program:

- Provides the knowledge, clinical skills, and evidence-based treatment strategies to effectively treat tobacco dependence
- Consists of focused instruction, interactive and hands-on learning activities, group discussion, and role-play
